We need to know as much as possible about a family's financial situation in order to consider all applicants equitably. All personal financial information is confidential. SSP financial aid is limited, and therefore, early application is strongly advised. Only accepted students who are US citizens or permanent residents may receive financial aid. Awards are granted on the basis of financial need, academic merit, and availability. Preference is given to high school juniors. Financial aid cannot cover all expenses, and only rarely does it cover any portion of room and board fees. We will continue to review completed financial help applications from admitted students until our scholarship fund is depleted. The final deadline for submitting financial aid applications is May 1; however, there is no guarantee that financial aid funds will still be available by that date.
